Submission guidelines

- Photographs of submissions must arrive by **November 9, 2009**.
- Entries must be made from 100% of **your** handspun yarn.
- Make a scarf of following the Button-Up Neck Warmer designed by Mavis Adam (pages 70–71 in the Summer 2009 issue of *Spin-Off* magazine. You may modify the pattern if you like—please note your changes.
- Keep track of your spinning details by filling out the form below as you spin.

- What to send:
 - A 4" x 6" photograph of the project (details are welcome, too). Please do not send the scarves at this time—just a photo. We'll contact the finalists and ask them to send their scarves.
 - A 4" x 4" swatch of the fabric.
 - A 1-yard sample of the yarn (if it is plied, submit a sample of the singles before plying as well as the plied yarn).
 - A sample of the fiber before spinning.
 - A hard copy **and** an electronic copy of the spinning details (either included in the mailing or emailed to aclarkemoore@interweave.com).
 - Your name, mailing address, phone number, and email address.
- Winning entries will be featured in the Spring 2010 issue of *Spin-Off*, runner's up will be featured on our website. Winning entries and runner's up items will be returned after March 15, 2010.
- Entrants will be notified of decisions via email by **January 10, 2010**. Entries that are not selected will be returned by **February 1, 2010**.
